2. Venue Details

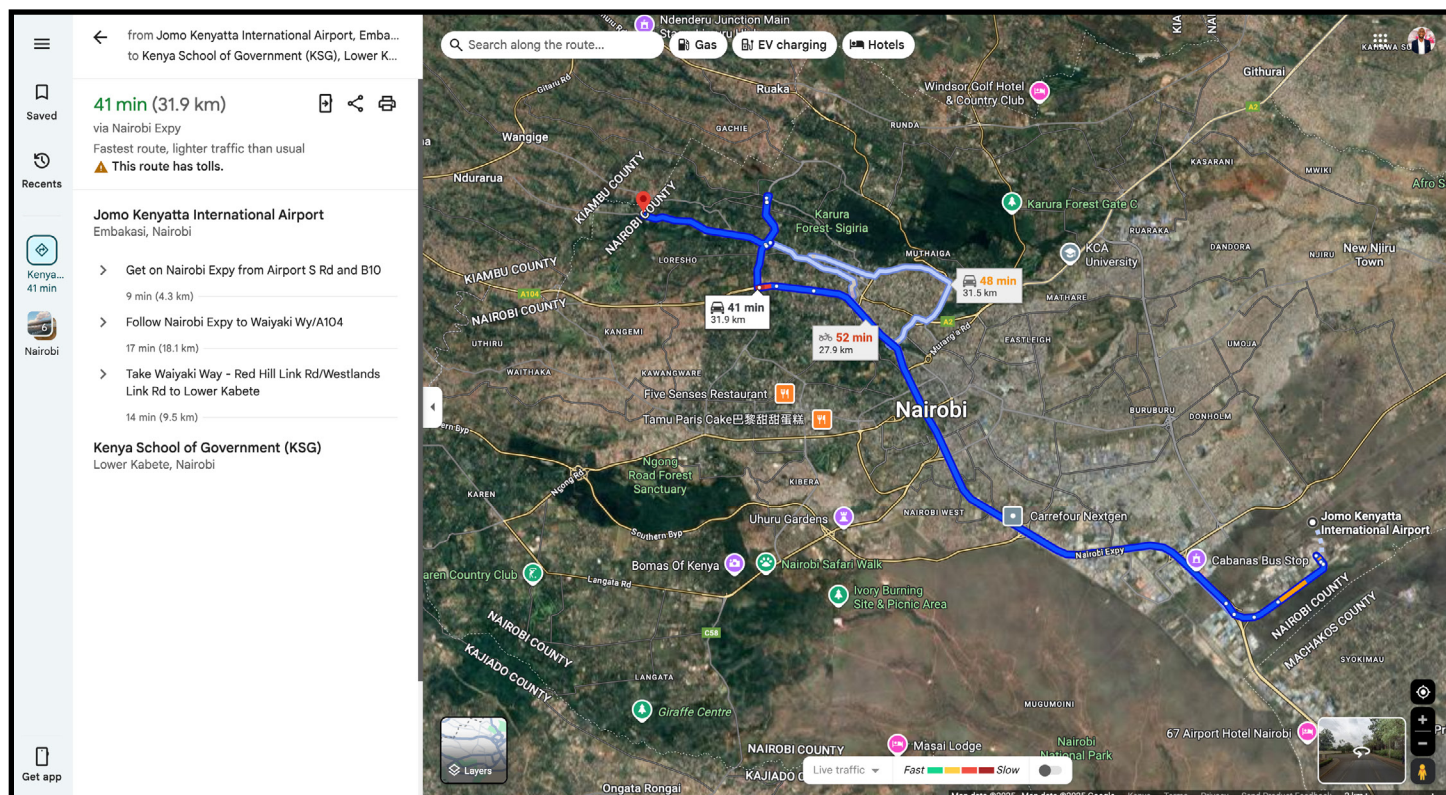
Kenya School of Government (KSG) - Lower Kabete Road, Nairobi, Kenya

Note: KSG is situated in a serene environment approximately 10 km from Nairobi's Central Business District (CBD) and about 27 km from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA).

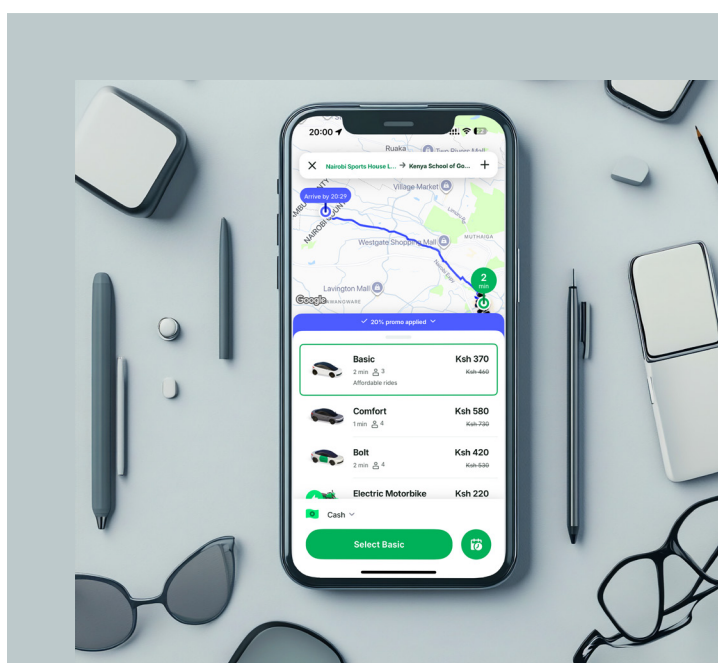
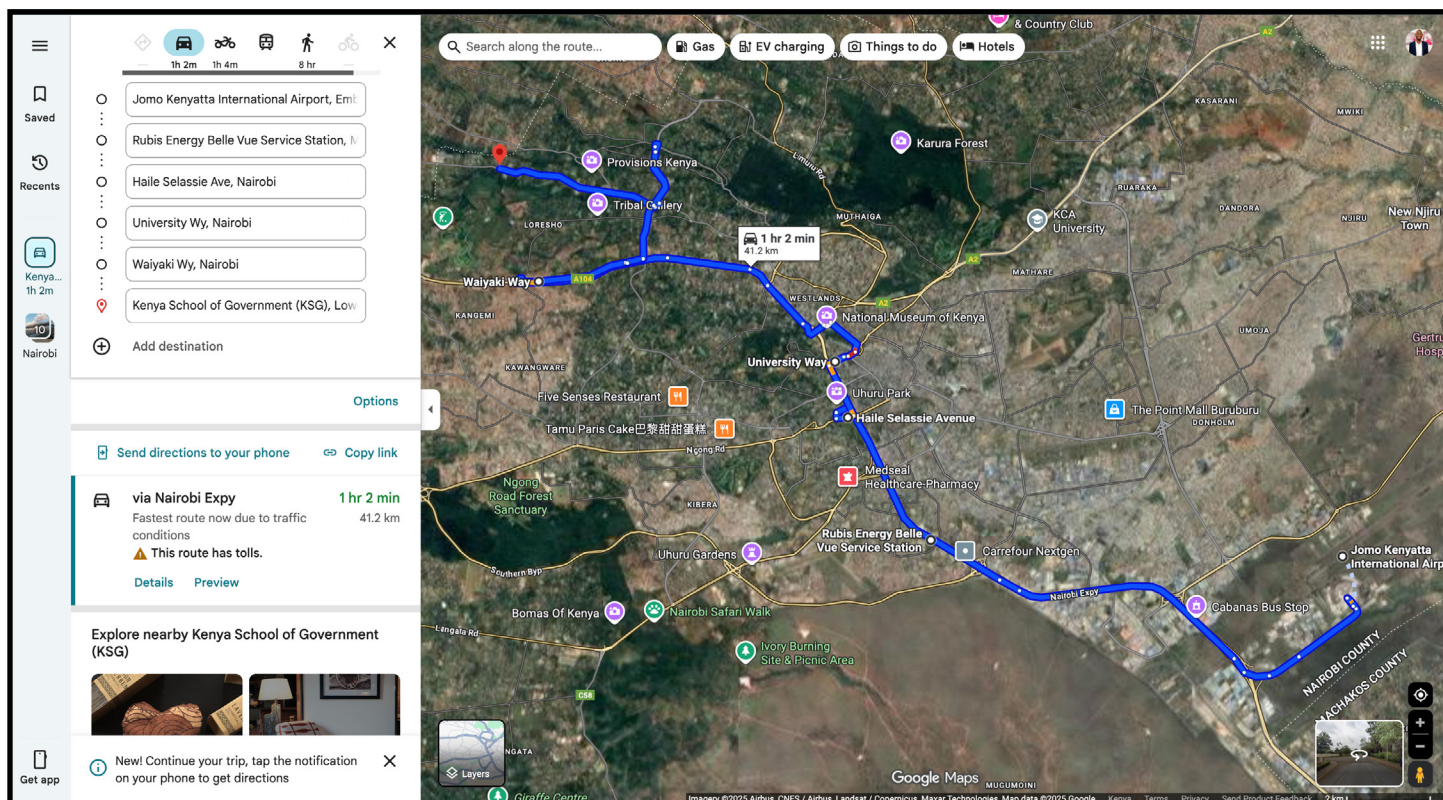
3. How to Access the Venue

From Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA)

- ◆ Distance: Approximately 27 km
- ◆ Estimated Travel Time: 45 – 75 minutes (depending on traffic)
- ◆ Recommended Route (via Nairobi Expressway):
- ◆ Exit JKIA and join the Nairobi Expressway heading towards Westlands.
- ◆ Exit at the Westlands Toll Station.
- ◆ Proceed along Waiyaki Way and turn right onto Lower Kabete Road (near Safaricom Headquarters/Sarit Centre). Continue for about 6 km to reach the Kenya School of Government (KSG).

Transport Options

Airport Taxis / Ride-Hailing Apps: Uber, Bolt and Little Cab are available at JKIA.

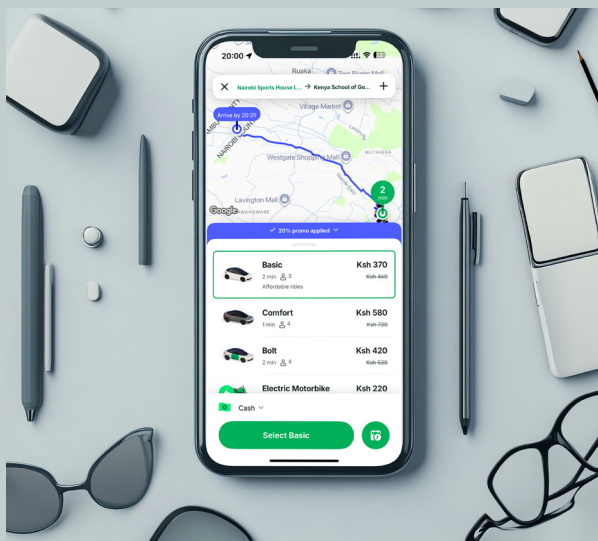
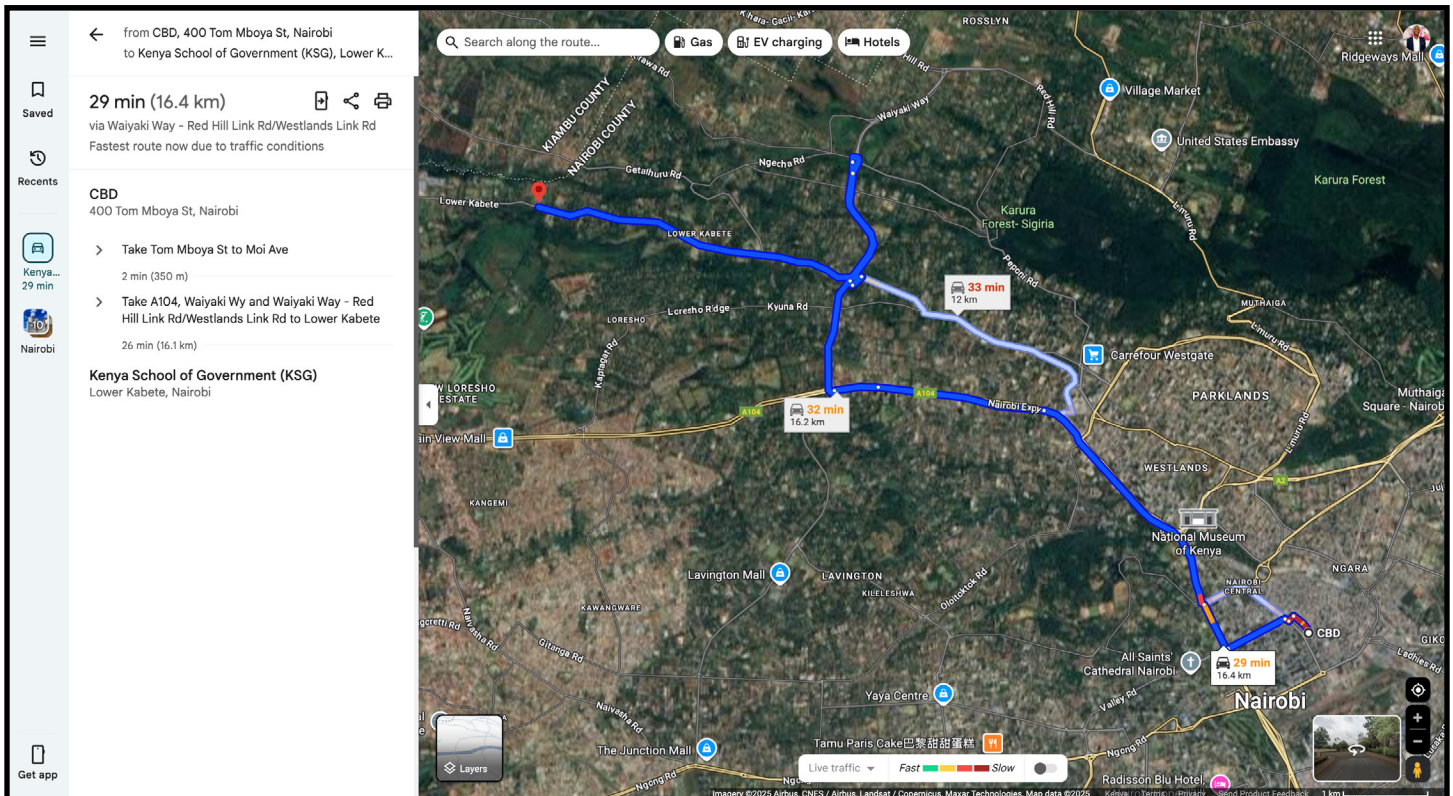
Private Transfers: Can be arranged through your hotel or the conference secretariat.

From Nairobi Central Business District (CBD)

- ◆ Distance: Approximately 10 km
- ◆ Estimated Travel Time: 20 – 40 minutes (depending on traffic)

Directions:

- ◆ From the CBD, take University Way or Waiyaki Way heading toward Westlands.
- ◆ Turn right onto Lower Kabete Road after Sarit Centre.
- ◆ Proceed for about 6 km; KSG will be on the right-hand side, clearly signposted.



Transport Options

Taxis or ride-hailing apps (Uber, Bolt, Little Cab).

Public Transport: Matatus on route 118 (Lower Kabete) are available from Khoja / Fig Tree terminus in the CBD.

4. Recommended Accommodation

Participants are encouraged to stay in hotels located in Westlands and Lower Kabete, which offer convenient access to the conference venue.
